

Options to Dulles Int'l Airport from Reagan National Airport

Dulles International Airport (IAD) – 29 miles

Public Transit:

- Take the Blue line to Rosslyn on the Largo/Washington DC bound train.
- Transfer to Silver line train on the Ashburn bound train to the Washington Dulles stop.

Estimated travel time is 75-90 minutes

Metrorail fare: Estimated fare is \$6.00

Metro hours: Monday-Thursday: 5am-Midnight; Friday: 5am – 1am; Saturday: 7am-1am; Sunday, 7am – Midnight

Uber/Lyft/other TNC

- Use app to request.
- Passenger must indicate which Terminal they are at and which door for pickup.
- Meet at third curb/sidewalk for Terminal 1
OR second curb/sidewalk for Terminal 2

Estimated travel time 45-80 minutes dependent on time of day

Estimated basic fare \$44 - \$57 and up. Depending on size of vehicle and time of day.

Taxi:

- Terminal 1: First curb/sidewalk
- Terminal 2: Baggage/Arrivals level, door 6

Estimated fare: \$85 if no traffic, plus gratuity. Cost varies dependent on time of day/traffic. Check exact fare with taxi dispatch representative

Driving Directions:

Option 1:

- GW Parkway North to 495 South** towards Virginia.
- Take **exit 45A** for VA-267 W toward Dulles Airport. Use left lane to take the exit toward Dulles Access Road. If you miss this exit towards the left, you will be required to pay a toll.
- Continue until you reach the airport.

Option 2, faster, but please note this option charges a variable toll from 3pm-7pm:

- Follow signs for GW Parkway, take GW Parkway North. Stay on GW Parkway (remain on right side at US 50 split).
- Take the left exit for Spout Run Parkway. At the second light, Langston Blvd, take a right.
- Then take the left turn to get onto I-66 West.
- From I-66, the lanes will split, stay to the right to exit for **I-495 North**.
- Then use left lane to exit towards **Dulles Access Road** (if you do not merge onto the Dulles Access road you will be charged at toll)

Estimated travel time 40-80 minutes dependent on time of day
