- Program Goals
 - To serve elderly and disabled homeowners
 - To serve households with children under six whose health is threatened by the presence of lead hazards
 - To facilitate aging in place among elderly households through accessibility modifications
 - To promote long-term affordability and lower operating costs through cost-effective, energyefficiency measures and performance testing.



- Program Scope
 - Maximum of \$45,000 per home for "hard costs".
 - Funds are 0% interest loans that are forgiven over time at the rate of \$3,000 per year
 - Household income must be less than 80% AMI for the county.




Floor Plan: The Hudson

Floor Plan: The Hudson










Floor Plan: The Baxter
